

Crazy for Ewe

MY HEART BEATS FOR EWE

Designed by Ginni Stein for our 2021 February Hat Club, this beanie features a cute heart-shaped cable. Knit in sturdy Kelbourne Germantown, this hat will last, even if love doesn't!

MATERIALS

YARN: 1 skein Kelbourne Woolens Germantown, color Scarlet (or 220 yards other worsted weight yarn)

NEEDLES: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" and US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" or size need to get gauge
US Size 7 (4.5mm) double pointed needles

CABLE NEEDLE

6 STITCH MARKERS

TAPESTRY NEEDLE

GAUGE

19 stitches per 4 inches on us size 7 in stockinette

NOTES AND ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is worked in the round, divided into 6 sections of 20 stitches each after completing the increase round. You may find it helpful to have the beginning of round marker look significantly different from your other 5 markers.



GLOSSARY

K – knit

P – purl

M1 (Make 1) – Insert left hand needle from front to back of horizontal strand of yarn lying between stitch just worked and next stitch. Knit through the back of loop lying over left needle.

pm – place marker

sm – slip marker

CN - cable needle

C4B – Slip 2 stitches from left needle to CN, hold in back. K2 from left needle, K2 from CN.

C4F – Slip 2 stitches from left needle to CN, hold in front. K2 from left needle, K2 from CN.

C4Rp – Slip 2 stitches from left needle to CN, hold in back. K2 from left needle, P2 from CN.

C4Lp – Slip 2 stitches from left needle to CN, hold in front. P2 from left needle, K2 from CN.

C3Rp – Slip 1 stitch from left needle to CN, hold in back. K2 from left needle, P1 from CN.

C3Lp – Slip 2 stitches from left needle to CN, hold in front. P1 from left needle, K2 from CN.

K2tog – Insert right needle into first 2 stitches on left needle, beginning with second stitch from end of left needle. Knit these 2 stitches together as if they were one.

SSK – Slip 2 stitches as if to knit, one at a time, from left needle to right needle, insert left needle tip through both front loops and knit together from this position.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needle and using the German Twisted Cast On method, or your preferred method, cast on 96 stitches. Join to work in round being careful not to twist stitches. Place a marker to indicate beginning of round.

Work 2" of K2, P2 rib.

Increase round: *K1, M1, K1, P2, repeat from * to end of round. (120 stitches)

Change to larger needle. Begin pattern rounds. (See Chart)

Rnd 1: *P4, K2, C4B, C4F, K2, P4, place marker, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 2: *P4, K12, P4, slip marker (sm), repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 3: *P4, C4Rp, K4, C4Lp, P4, sm, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 4: *P4, K2, P2, K4, P2, K2, P4, sm, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 5: *P3, C3Rp, P2, C4B, P2, C3Lp, P3, sm, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 6: *P3, K2, P3, K4, P3, K2, P3, sm, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 7: *P2, C3Rp, P3, K4, P3, C3Lp, P2, sm, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 8: *P2, K2, P4, K4, P4, K2, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 9: *P2, K2, P4, C4B, P4, K2, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 10: *P2, K2, P4, K4, P4, K2, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 11: *P2, C4Lp, C4B, C4F, C4Rp, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 12: P4, K12, P4, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnds 13-22: Repeat Rounds 3-12.

Rnds 23-30: Repeat Rounds 3-10.

Rnd 31: *P2, C4Lp, C4Rp, C4Lp, C4Rp, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 32: *P4, K4, P4, K4, P4, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 33: *P4, C4B, P4, C4B, P4, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 34: *P4, K4, P4, K4, P4, repeat from * to end of round.

Begin pattern shaping for crown. *Change to dpns as necessary.*

Rnd 35: *P3, K2tog, K3, P4, K3, SSK, P3, repeat from * to

end of round. (108 sts)

Rnd 36: *P3, K4, P4, K4, P3, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 37: *P3, C4B, P4, C4B, P3, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 38: *P3, K4, P4, K4, P3, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 39: *P2, K2tog, K2, SSK, P2, K2tog, K2, SSK, P2, repeat from * to end of round. (84 sts)

Rnd 40: *P2, K4, P2, K4, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 41: *P2, C4B, P2, C4B, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 42: *P2, K4, P2, K4, P2, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 43: *P1, K2tog, K2, SSK, K2tog, K2, SSK, P1, repeat from * to end of round. (60 sts)

Rnd 44: *P1, K8, P1, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 45: *P1, C4B, C4B, P1, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 46: *P1, K8, P1, repeat from * to end of round.

Rnd 47: *K2tog, K6, SSK, repeat from * to end of round. (48 sts)

Rnd 48: K2tog to end of round. (24 sts)

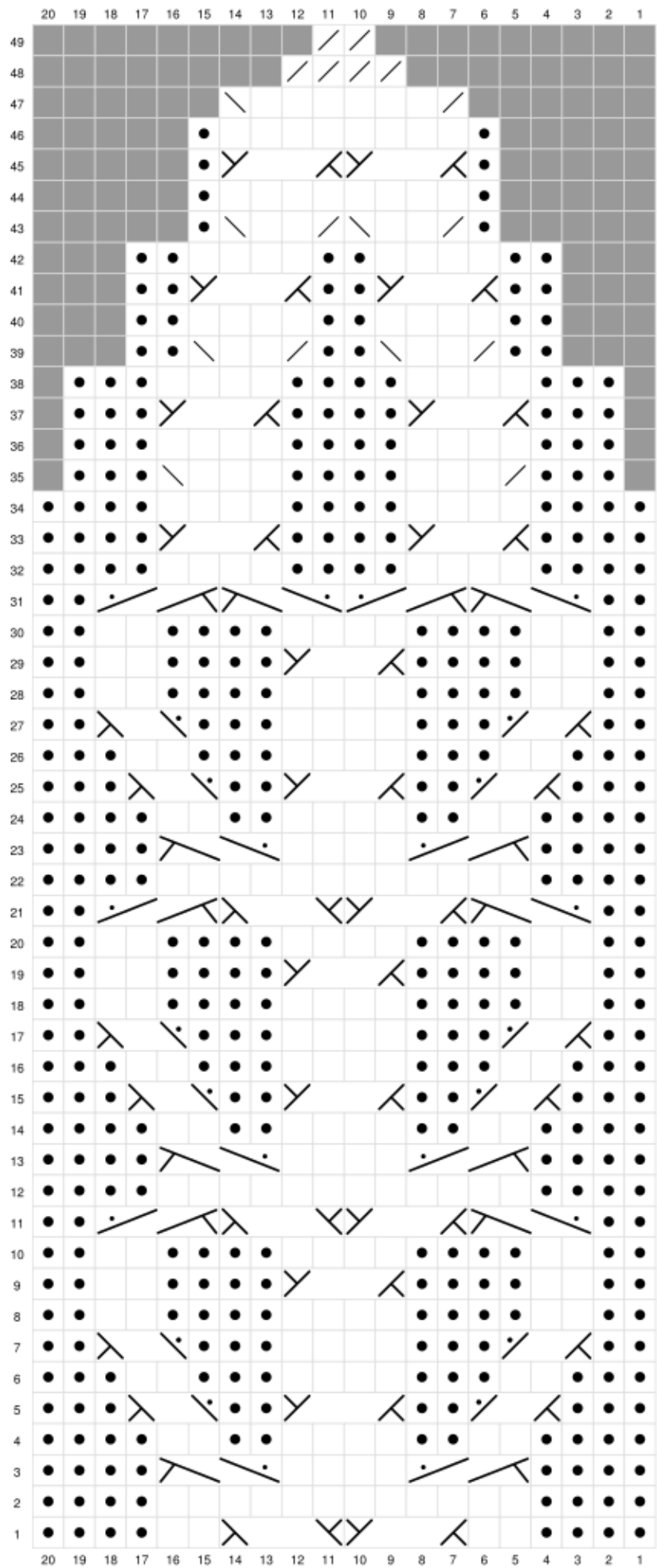
Rnd 49: Repeat Rnd 48. (12 sts)












Finishing:

Cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches with a tapestry needle; tighten, then pull to inside and secure.

Weave in ends. Attach pompom.
