STRIPED
SHAWL

Striped Shawl

The alternating shades of *Kureyon* in this triangular wrap creates stripe patterns that are colorful yet subtle and sophisticated.

Skill Level: ●●●○

Materials

- Three 50g balls of Noro *Kureyon* in #188 (A) and #252 (B).
- Size US 8 (5mm) circular needle, 47in (119cm) long, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.
- Tapestry needle.

Knitted Measurements

60in (152.5cm) wide x 32in (81cm) long.

Gauge

13 sts and 23 rows = 4in (10cm) over Stockinette st using size US 8 (5mm) needle. TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

Abbreviations

k	knit	ssk	slip, slip, knit
k2tog	knit next two stitches together	st(s)	stitch(es)
p	purl	S2KP	slip two stitches together, knit 1, pass two slipped stitches over one stitch knitted
patt	pattern	WS	wrong side(s)
rem	remain(ing)		
rep	repeat		
RS	right side(s)		



Stripe Pattern

Work 8 rows with A, then 8 rows with B; rep from * for Stripe patt.

Shawl

With A, cast on 251 sts. Work in Stripe patt as follows:

Row 1 (RS) With A, k2, ssk, k120, S2KP, k120, k2tog, k2—247 sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3 K2, ssk, k118, S2KP, k118, k2tog, k2—243 sts.

Row 5 K2, ssk, k116, S2KP, k116, k2tog, k2—239 sts.

Row 7 K2, ssk, k114, S2KP, k114, k2tog, k2—235 sts.

Row 9 With B, k2, ssk, k112, S2KP, k112, k2tog, k2—231 sts.

Row 11 K2, ssk, k110, S2KP, k110, k2tog, k2—227 sts.

Row 13 K2, ssk, k108, S2KP, k108, k2tog, k2—223 sts.

Row 15 K2, ssk, k106, S2KP, k106, k2tog, k2—219 sts.

Cont in patt as established, working 2 fewer k sts on each side of center S2KP every RS row, until last row worked is:

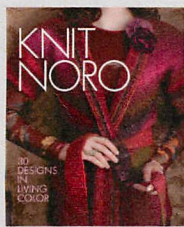
Row 121 With B, k2, ssk, S2KP, k2tog, k2—7 sts.

Row 123 K2, S2KP, k2—5 sts.

Break yarn, weave through rem sts and secure on WS.

Finishing

Weave in all loose ends with tapestry needle. Block well. ■
